

CME Outcomes/Evaluation Methods and NYU Winthrop/Long Island School of Medicine

This course will incorporate a variety of evaluation methods including the following:

1. Audience Response

During the workshop, an Audience Response System will be utilized to periodically pose questions to participants and foster interactive learning. Audience Response may include pre-testing of the same MOC questions that appear in post-test.

2. MOC Post-Test

Using a mix of knowledge recall and case-based competency multiple-choice test questions, we will measure **Moore's Level 3 and Moore's Level 4** for a subset of learners who are Boarded Diplomates of the American Board of Pediatrics(ABP), American Board of Internal Medicine(ABIM), American Board of Pathology(ABPath), or American Board of Anaesthesiology(ABA).

3. Exit Evaluation •

Level 3b and above evaluation on Moore's Levels of Outcomes Scale. Participants will receive an online, **post-activity survey** that will ask them to describe the practice and behavior changes they that they plan to make as a result of attending the educational program, among other standard evaluation survey questions.

4. Post-Activity Follow-up Assessment

Lastly, a 90 day post-activity survey will be sent to all participants to measure the level and type of practice changes made as a result of the activity.
