Fall Research Forum: Building Debriefing Expertise: A Qualitative Study of Novice Debriefers' Post-Simulation Debriefing Experiences

Description: In the last 10 years, the use of simulation in health professions education increased dramatically. Simulation typically involve students participating in patient care scenarios, followed by faculty-guided debriefing. Research shows that in order for learning to occur, debriefings need to be conducted by instructors with specific debriefing expertise. However, at present, research shows up to 80% of instructors are novices in debriefing, and may not be able to use simulation effectively to achieve maximum learning outcomes. The aim of this program is to better understand novice debriefers' experiences across health professions and institutions.
